

OFF-PREMISE ACTIVITY AUTHORIZATION

There are times when the students from the Children’s House may be taken to the grassy area outside the playground fence for various activities. Day care licensing requires that we have parental permission to be outside that fence for any group activities we may do (examples include exploratory walks around school campus for leaf gathering or celebratory all school gatherings on the open grass.)

“Off-premise activities” refer to any activity which takes place away from a “licensed and approved space”. License and approved space includes primary space (classrooms), outdoor space (playground fenced), single use rooms (such as gymnasium), or other administrative areas that have been approved for use.
