



Children's House Supply List 2017-2018

Welcome back to school!

Supplies that your child will need to bring to school:

- 1 box of tissue
- Elmer's washable glue sticks-package of 3 or 6(6 g) size or 2(22 g) size
- 2 containers of Playdough-your choice of color
- 1 package of watercolor paper
- 1 Child sized scissors
- Elmer's glue (small bottle)
- Lunch box (for children who stay all day)

Firefly's (Ms. Ali's class)

- Cray-pod (pastel) crayons
- Skinny markers
- Dry erase markers
- Bag of colored sand (A.C. Moore)
- Round colored or white pricing tag stickers

Dragonfly's (Ms. Veronica's class)

- Water color paints
- Fat markers
- Colored chalk
- Letter sized white envelopes
- Round colored or white tag pricing stickers
- Molding clay

Optional Donation List

- Moonsand (Kinetic Sand)
- Sunflower seeds for bird feeders
- Ream of copy paper

Your child will also need to have:

- **Slippers** for indoors labeled with your child's name-please do not send flip flop style shoes, shoes with cartoon character on them or slipper type shoes with no back. Slippers should conform to the foot and give support.

- **Water bottle (only for the children who stay all day, the day class will use glass cups for water)** filled and labeled with your child's name and date. The date must be changed each day per day care regulations. We will send home the water bottle each day.

- **A change of clothes** appropriate to the season in a labeled ziploc bag. This will be kept at school. Be sure to include underwear and socks. Make sure you label all clothing items, even the socks.

- **A canvas bag** that will hold your child's belongings. Please do not send a backpack with your child as these do not fit on the hooks or in the cubbies.

- **2 pictures of your child**-These may be mailed in to 101 Carver Ave, Black Mountain, NC 28711. We would like to have these before your child's first day at school. We will be using your child's picture to create a work for the students to use in their classroom. You can also bring these to Parent Orientation night.

Nappers (age 3) staying past 12:00pm: children are encouraged to sleep/rest. If your child is under the age of 4, or if they are still in need of a nap, you are required to bring the following items:

- **1 labeled sheet** (the small crib size sheet fits the mats)
- **1 labeled lightweight crib blanket**

A few reminders:

- All coats, sweaters, gloves and hats need to be labeled with your child's name. We often find that the children lose these items and then don't recognize them as their own. We do take all unclaimed lost and found items to local charities.
- We ask that students do not bring any toys to school, including Before and After Care.
